





SINGAPORE AIRLINES' MIGRATION TO POINT OF COMMENCMENT (POC) LOGIC FOR EDIFACT BOOKINGS

From 17 June 2025, Singapore Airlines (SIA) will use a Point of Commencement (POC) system to manage seat availability on EDIFACT channels. This change ensures that inventory availability is consistent across all booking platforms.

What is POC?

Point of Commencement (POC) refers to the starting point of a passenger's journey. Bookings must follow the passenger's actual travel sequence. This means all flights, including connecting ones with other airlines, must be booked in the same order as the passenger intends to travel.

What does this mean for travel agents?

- If a passenger changes their itinerary and starts their journey from a different location, please cancel the original PNR and create a new PNR, where possible. Keep in mind that seat availability will depend on what's available at the time of booking.
- Avoid making bookings with out-of-sequence flights or dummy segments. These will be flagged as POC violations, and SIA reserves the right to cancel them.

What happens to changes made after 17 June 2025?

- Any changes to bookings, even those ticketed before 17 June 2025, will follow the new POC seat availability rules.
- If no changes are made to a flight, agents should process the booking as long as the original booking class (RBD) is still available. If the RBD is no longer available, contact your local SIA Sales Operations for help.









Examples

Prohibited method - out of sequence booking

Step	Travel Agent has booked One Way SINFRA for 01 August and requests to add FRASIN departure on 01 June to try and secure Q class on SINFRA
1	Retrieve the PNR

	Check availabilty on new outbound segment
	If there is no availabiloty for the new outbound segment, we will recommend rebooking them into a new PNR

Step	Passenger requests to changing the outbound flight with change of POC country
1	Retrieve the PNR
