

Singapore Airlines and Air New Zealand formed an alliance in 2014, allowing the two airlines to operate codeshare services on flights between New Zealand and Singapore from January 2015.

As part of this alliance, Air New Zealand and Singapore Airlines offer 3x daily services between Auckland and Singapore year-round, with a fourth daily flight to operate seasonally during northern winter.

A service between Christchurch and Singapore is also offered daily, and will increase to 10 times weekly seasonally during northern winter.

For passengers wishing to travel, codeshare services are available from 20 points within New Zealand on to more than 25 destinations across Southeast Asia, India, the United Kingdom, and Europe.

- Premium customer handling is based on Star Alliance standards for Air New Zealand and Singapore Airlines operated flights.
- Airpoints™ members are able to earn Airpoints Dollars™ and Status Points when flying on eligible Singapore Airlines operated flights. Similarly, KrisFlyer members can also earn KrisFlyer Miles and Elite Miles* on eligible Air New Zealand operated flights.

- Premium check-in counters will be available for eligible customers when travelling on either carrier.
- To ensure that Airpoints™ Elite, Elite Partner, Gold and Koru and KrisFlyer Elite Gold, KrisFlyer Elite Silver and PPS Club members receive premium benefits, they should always have their frequent flyer number entered into their booking.
- Airport self check-in kiosks are available in New Zealand for Domestic and International passengers travelling on Air New Zealand operated flights only.
- · Through-check is available when travelling on more than one sector and when all the sectors are issued on the same ticket and booked in the same PNR. Customers will receive all boarding passes at the first airport in which they check in.
- · For stopovers less than 48 hours in Singapore, Singapore Airlines allows for baggage to be checked through.
- Dedicated check-in counters are available at Auckland and Christchurch International terminals for passengers travelling on Singapore Airlines operated flights.

Points to note

Key points when booking an alliance journey:

- Unaccompanied minors and MEDA pax are not permitted to be booked on NZ3200 NZ3699 and SQ4200 SQ4599 series flights. For further details on unaccompanied minors and MEDA pax, please see the operating carrier's website.
- Child fares apply to children aged 2-11 on Air New Zealand and Singapore Airlines flights based on Operating Carrier rules.
- For infants travelling on Singapore Airlines who turn 2 years of age at any point during the journey, the agent must contact SIA to assign a child seat for the remainder of travel (no additional costs involved). For NZ operated flights, if an infant turns 2 years of age at any point of the ticketed journey the infant must occupy a seat and purchase a child fare.


